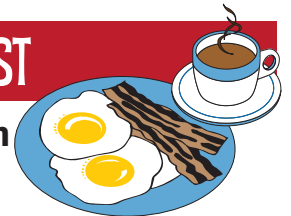

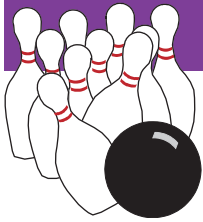

MOTOWN MUSEUM

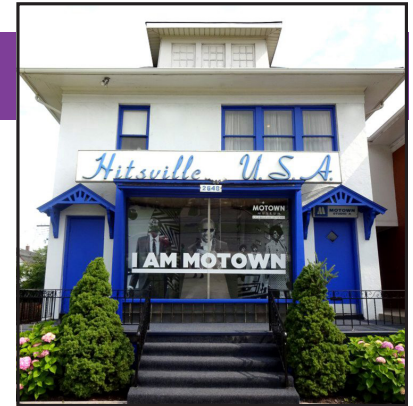

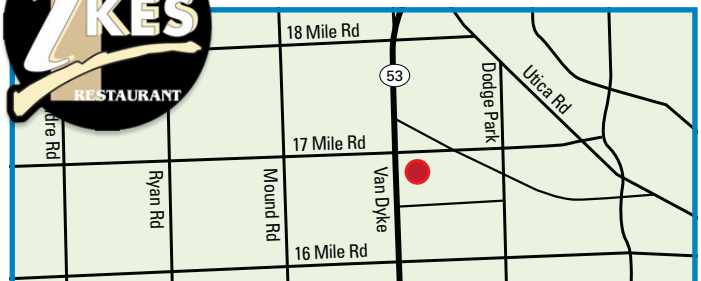
