

• Friday night gather at Paddle Brave for campfire. Bring snacks to pass if you wish.



When you pay, be sure to say you are sending to a friend to avoid service charges. Once 20 camping spots are paid for, it will be closed.

The Metropolitan Detroit Ski Council Contract (referred to as MDSC)
