





Fiddler on the Roof is an epic and timeless musical that is both a spirited, humorous look at rural life and a serious portrait of sweeping change. It is the story of the small, tradition-steeped town of Anatevka, set in Tsarist Russia in 1905, where Jews and Russians live in a delicate balance on the eve of revolution. It's a tale of family tradition, wit, and sorrow told through the many trials of Tevye, a Jewish Everyman.

The poor hard-working, and witty milkman lives in the fictional village clinging firmly to his faith and traditions, dreaming of riches he'll never see. Tevye believes that he'll need a matchmaker to marry off his three oldest daughters, but Tzeitel, Hodel, and Chava soon force their more modern ideas upon him, each daughter pursuing romance in her own different and unconventional way. The musical begins in darkness with a mesmerizing violin solo hitting all the notes to create an atmosphere containing the powerful emotional breadth of the story: joy, regret, humor, love, nostalgia, heartbreak and celebration. Enjoy Fiddler's famous songs "Sunrise, Sunset", "If I Were A Rich Man", and "Matchmaker, Matchmaker".
